Program Success!

Sometimes the best way to keep a horse from becoming a statistic is by helping the humans who care for them. We accomplish this two ways with the first being our very active Saving Grace Program. Whether it is a helping hand to provide feed and hay to horses owners who have fallen on hard times or helping an owner find solutions to dealing with their equines poor health or death. We accomplish this through our Saving Grace program named after an older mare whose owner did not realize they had an option until after the horse was given to a known slaughter buyer. Your support allows us to offer options which in turn offers hope.



Along with us helping owners directly, we are thrilled with the completion of our Equine Care Handbook. Because of a generous grant, we are distributing 1,000 copies across the volunteer state to county officials who handle the initial calls dealing with equine complaints. This educational tool will help open communication between law enforcement and owners. Our goal is to encourage change instead of confiscation through education. This should lessen the burden on all entities across the state.
