We have distributed 650 booklets to 26 different entities who handle the initial calls dealing with equine complaints. I had the opportunity to witness the books being distributed to three owners during an investigation were I was called to intercede on. This educational tool helps open communication between law enforcement and owners. In this

particular case, three horses (2 pictured above) were surrendered over to Hearts of Horse Haven and Animal Control continues to monitor the welfare of the others left with owners. Our latest update is the remaining animals are doing good and show definite signs of improvement and the owners are complying with the plan of action wrote for them. Our goal is to encourage change instead of confiscation through education.

When the opportunity arose for her to enter the Rally for the Rescues training competition this spring, we were thrilled. This would give her the opportunity to work one-on-one with a young trainer to learn manners and

basic handling skills. Two of our Board members delivered Clara to her appointed trainer Breanna in early June. What Kristen and Lucy witnessed 120 days later at the competition was beyond anything they could have hoped. Breanna did such a great job, and she said Clara was a good student who tried hard to please. Clara won the Fan Favorite award and was Grand Champion in her class competition. Because Clara was not adopted during the event, she was brought back to East Tennessee and placed into foster care. She has since found a new home and bonded quickly with her new owner as she enjoys the time she spends with him. Both are learning to become a team and we hope to see them on the trails or in the show ring in the near future. We would like to thank all those behind the scenes that made this event possible. **The Need for Your Support** - Caring for a horse is expensive.
