Along with placement of equine in need, we had the opportunity to help multiple communities this past year. When flooding hit Hickman and surrounding counties, we teamed up with Freedom Reigns Ranch in

Thompson Station, TN to help. Carissa lined up drop off points for donated supplies and her volunteers made for sure they got picked up and distributed to owners in need. Collaboration is what rescue is all about in Tennessee.

Because we knew they had plenty of feed and hay already donated we decided to fill a different need for equine owners. The floods were so strong it wiped out fencing in pastures and owners had no way to contain their horses. We were able to purchase \$3000+ in supplies at a Tractor Supply close to the area and have them delivered to the drop off point. Hearts of Horse Haven donated t-posts, insulators, post caps, electric braided fencing and solar fence chargers to enable owners to get safe containment areas up as quickly as possible.

Because of your support throughout the year, you helped us make this happen. Sometimes the best way to keep a horse from becoming a statistic is by helping the humans who care for them. Whether it is a helping hand to provide feed and hay to horse owners who have fallen on hard times or helping an owner find solutions to dealing with their equines poor health or death.
